COM35.0/21 REPORT ON FAMILY FUN DAY

It had been extremely well attended with well over 200 children and parents present, indeed the operators of the fun rides reported over 2000 rides had been used. Cllr. P.Malpass wished to place on record her thanks to all who had assisted with the event and especially the companies in Chilton who had supported by their sponsorship. This is the first event being held in the Wheatsheaf Public House, and the Committee now plan to organise other events in both Chilton WMC and Chilton Catholic Club during this Civic year. Several members expressed their thanks and congratulations to Cllr. P.Malpass and her helpers for an excellent event.

Cllr. M.Young asked for a costing of the event, and who had approved the funding. The cost had been £900. The Town Clerk advised the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Community
